2020 GENERAL ELECTION

Tuesday, November 3, 2020

On March 18, 2020, Governor Greg Abbott issued a proclamation suspending the provisions of the Texas Election Code to allow political subdivisions to postpone their 2020 local elections.

Municipal election for the City of Wilmer will be held on **Tuesday, November 3, 2020** for the election of a **Mayor** and **two (2) Council Members**.

Only legally qualified voters of the City of Wilmer shall be entitled to vote. The last day to register to vote in the 2020 General Municipal Election is **October 5, 2020**.
